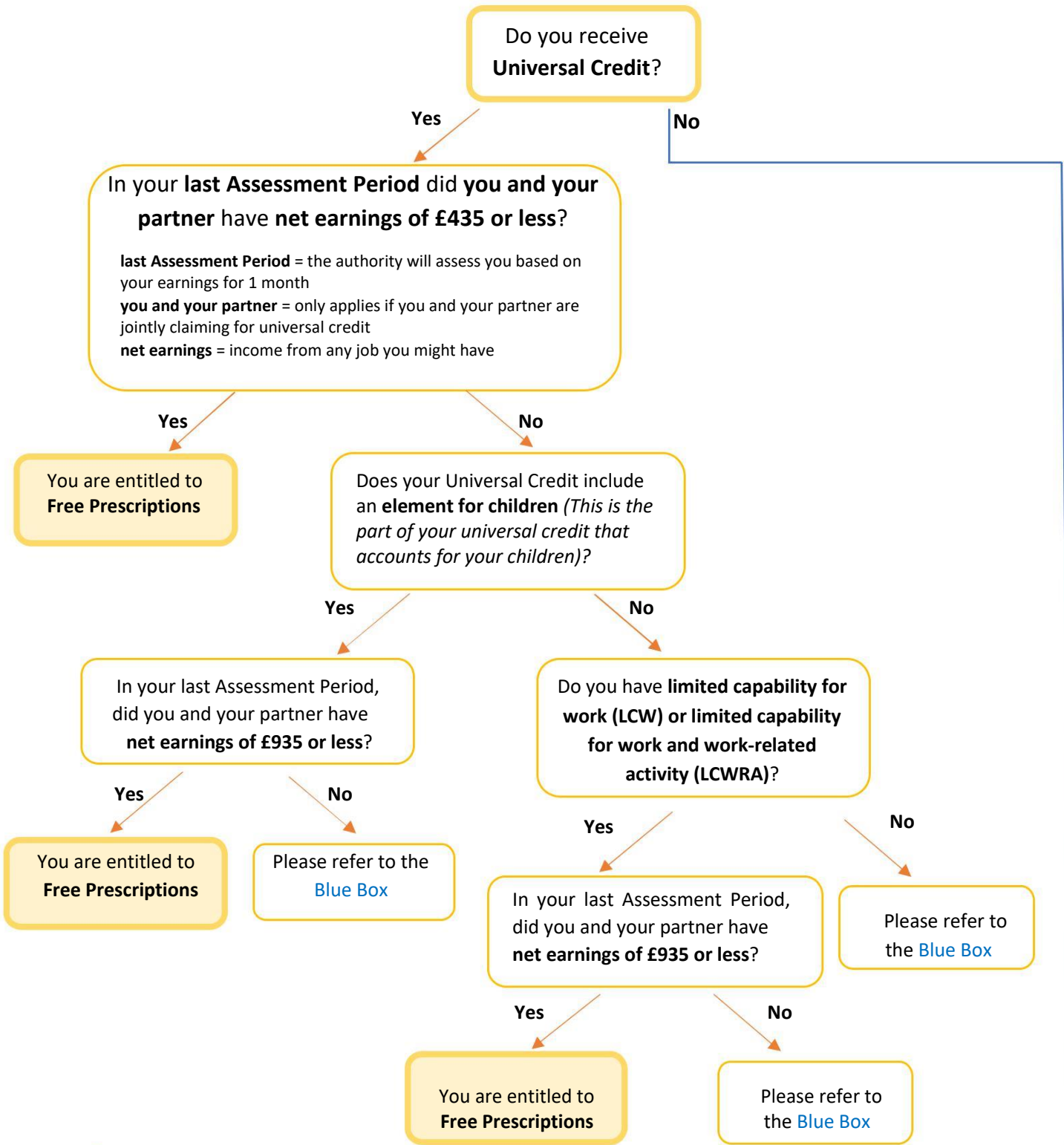


Am I Entitled to NHS Free Prescriptions?

It can be confusing to work out if you are entitled to free prescriptions or not, especially if you are on Universal Credit. Follow the steps below to help you figure out if you can get free prescriptions.



You **will still qualify** for full help with health costs if you get:

Income Support / Income related employment and support allowance / Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance / The guarantee credit part of Pension Credit / Working Tax Credit and/or Child Tax Credit,

Or if you are

Over 60 / Having treatment for cancer / Live in Wales / Live in Scotland / Are pregnant / have had a baby in last 12 months and you have an exemption certificate

Alternatively, you might be eligible under the **NHS Low Income Scheme** or check <https://www.nhs.uk/using-the-nhs/help-with-health-costs/get-help-with-prescription-costs/> for more information.
